What could be better than spending a weekend cycle racing with your team over four testing stages? Sprinters, GC or climbers the TOG offers something for everyone. We hope the fun began long before the event as you formed teams and began some intensive team training. .

The TOG Committee welcomes you all to the seventh staging of the TOG.

Blow out the cobwebs on the Stage 1 PEDAL ACTION COACHING/FINNIS GENERAL STORE 15KM Time Trial. This year everyone does the 15km so there'll be no chance of wrong turns! EADES TRANSPORT is again sponsoring the Finniss-Clayton-Milang Road Race. It may be a flat stage but for many it may feel like a long haul. Whatever the outcome The Royal Family Hotel at Port Elliot will be an excellent place to gather for a meal on Saturday night while you contemplate Sunday's tactics.

Craig Ingram set the men's target last year at 09:18.59 while the longstanding record for females is Nusha Kerin's 11:04.3.

Pedal Action/Finniss General Store Stage 1 Time Trial

TEAM TIME TRIAL

Distance - 15km

Teams - The team's time is taken on the finish time of the third rider. Each rider will be given their actual finish time for the purposes of the individual GC competition. Prize money for Stage 1 is for the Team placings only

Individuals – Riders who are racing in the Divisions as individuals will start in groups of 3-5 riders (depending on numbers) and are permitted to draft off riders in the same start group. In effect this group can race as Team time trial in order to be equitable with riders in the teams competition. There is however, no compunction for individuals to remain within the group as they are racing for individual time only and are free to ride as best suits their purposes. Each rider will be given their own individual time.

Prize money for Stage 1 is for the team placings only.

F Grade (15 km)

Riders will set off from the General Store in 1 minute intervals. No drafting of other riders is allowed in F Grade.






Equipment

All time trial equipment approved for use by the AVCC (eg TT bikes, disc wheels, skinsuits and aero helmets) is allowed for all riders. No drafting of vehicles or riders with differing start times is permitted.

Transponders

If using a dedicated time trial bike for the Stage1 Time Trial please ensure that your Orion transponder is mounted on it. No transponder means no recorded time!

At the completion of the time trial also remember to put the transponder back on your road bike for the next road stage.

Eades Transport Stage 2 Finniss Road Race

The big loop. Can you back up after this mornings efforts? It's flat but it will be windy.

The Course

Stage 2

From the General Store in Finniss riders will head to the Finniss -Milang Road.

Divisions 1 and 2 will turn toward Clayton and on to Milang and then back to Finniss. They will then do another lap. Divisions 3, 4, and 5 will initially continue along the Finniss-Milang Road until the turnaround point near Nine Mile Road, head back toward Finniss and then turn left toward Clayton and onto Milang and Finniss. F Grade only do one Clayton lap and do not go out to the turnaround.

Div 1 & 2 - 85km Div 3, 4 & 5 - 66km F Grade - 43 km



Time Bonuses

Time bonuses are available for the first 6 riders at the finish.


Time bonuses are also on offer to the first 5 riders to cross the finish line area on lap 1 (heading westward - not F Grade). The Clayton Sprint also has time bonuses available.

Finish - 15, 10, 7, 5, 3, 2 seconds

End of Lap 1 - 10, 6, 4, 3, 2 seconds

(Not F Grade)

Clayton Sprint 10, 6, 4, 3, 2 seconds (Lap 1 only)

Hilly Road Race

Zero Friction Cycling/Royal Family Hotel Port Elliot Stage 3 Flagstaff Hill Road Race

Starting near Investigator College in Goolwa this course provides a challenging start to day 2 with multiple ascents of the short but very sharp Flagstaff Hill Rd.

F Grade will start at the top of Flagstaff Hill and complete a single loop of the course

Distance

Div 1,2 : 46.8 km Div 3, 4, 5 : 28.3 km F Grade : 17.5 km

Start Times

From 9:30am






Time bonuses

First time top of Flagstaff Hill 5, 3, 2 seconds (not F Grade) Finish – 7, 5, 3, 2, 1 seconds

Parking

All cars are to be parked in the paddock provided at the top of the hill. This will be clearly signposted. No cars are to be parked along the roadside due to safety concerns.





Crows Nest Hill Climb

D & A Kelly Concrete "HARDEN UP" **Crow's Nest Hill Climb Stage 4**

Distance: 4km

Average Gradient: 6% Elevation Gain: 222m

An individual hill climb Time Trial from Port Elliott and up the beautiful Crow's Nest Road. This is it, the final stage. The team's time is taken as the sum of the 3 fastest riders' times.

Take a teaspoon of wet cement and harden up! Precious time can be gained or lost here for those with GC aspirations. Suck it up and go hard. No time bonuses on offer for this stage so make it count.

Start

The staging area for riders is at the base of Crows Nest/Waterport Rd. Riders should ensure they are at the staging area at least 5 minutes before their allocated start time.

Start Times

From 2:00 PM

Riders in Divisions 1-5 will be sent off as individual teams or composite

groups of 3-5 riders as per stage 1. Riders do not have to ride together and are permitted to draft only off riders from their own start group.

Riders in F Grade will be set off at 30 second intervals as directed by the starter. During the event, riders in F Grade are not permitted to draft behind other riders or vehicles.

Cash bonus for record breakers

\$50 cash bonus for anyone who can set a new ToG record on the Crows Nest climb.

Fastest Times




