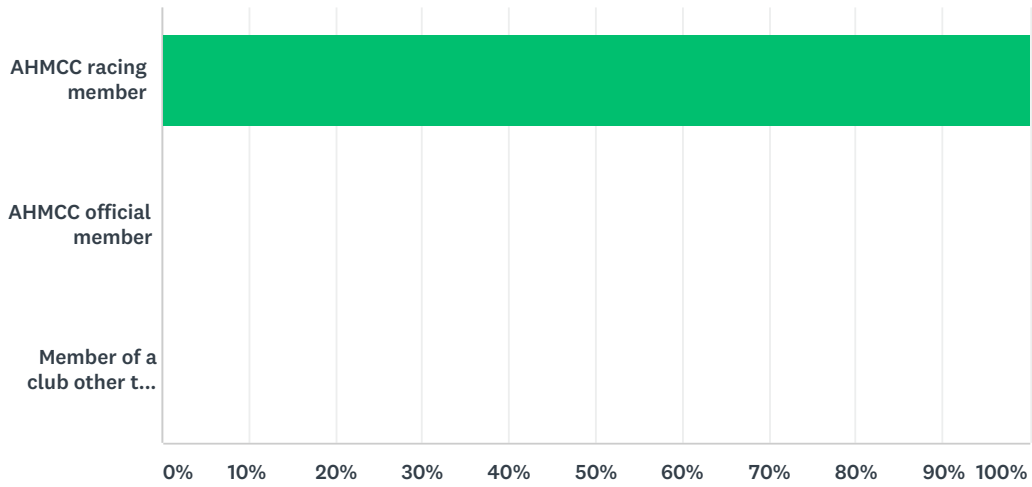


Q1 Q1 What is your membership arrangement? (select one answer)

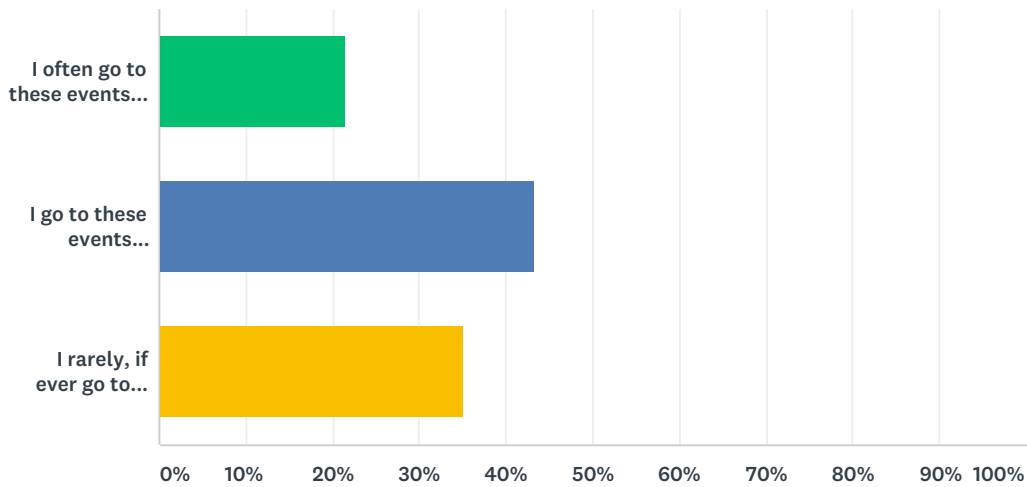

Q2 For open and invitation events held by Southern Vets (SDVLCC) (select one answer)

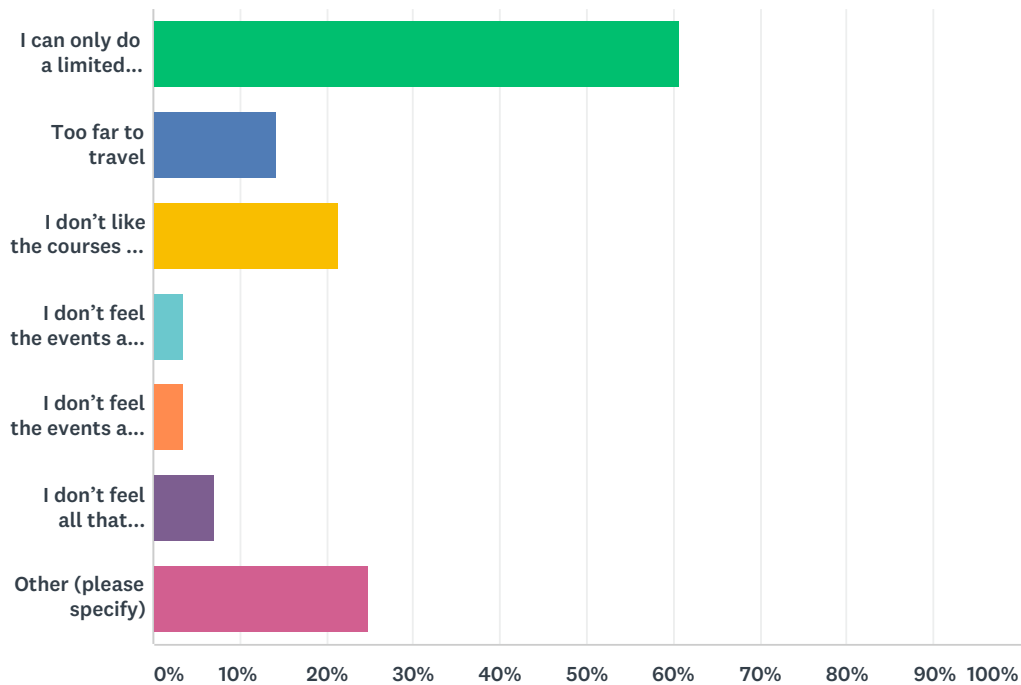

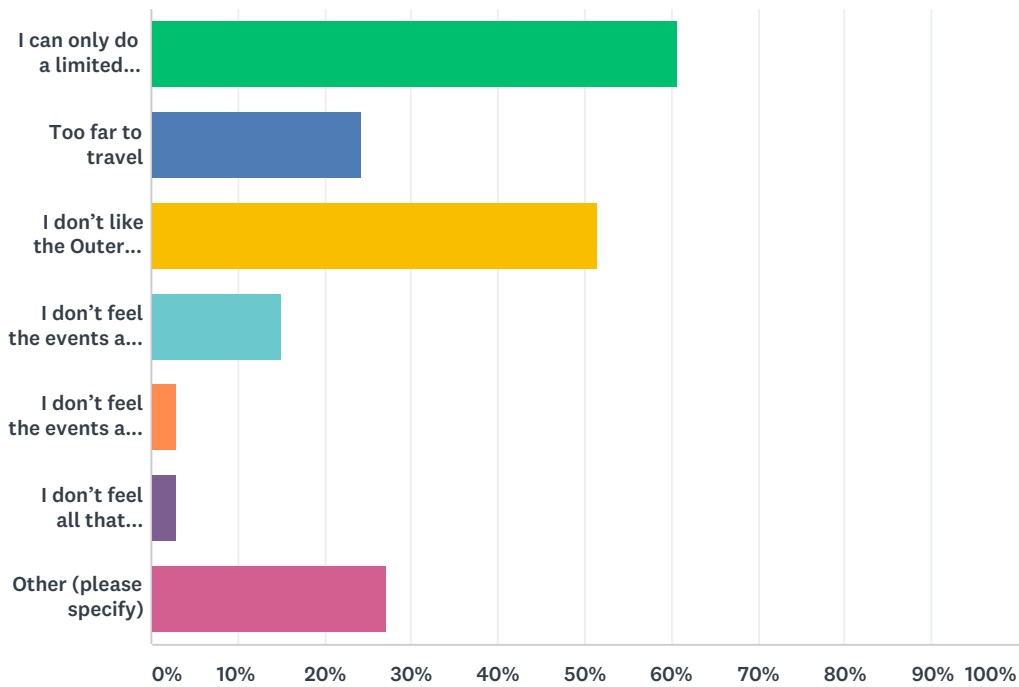

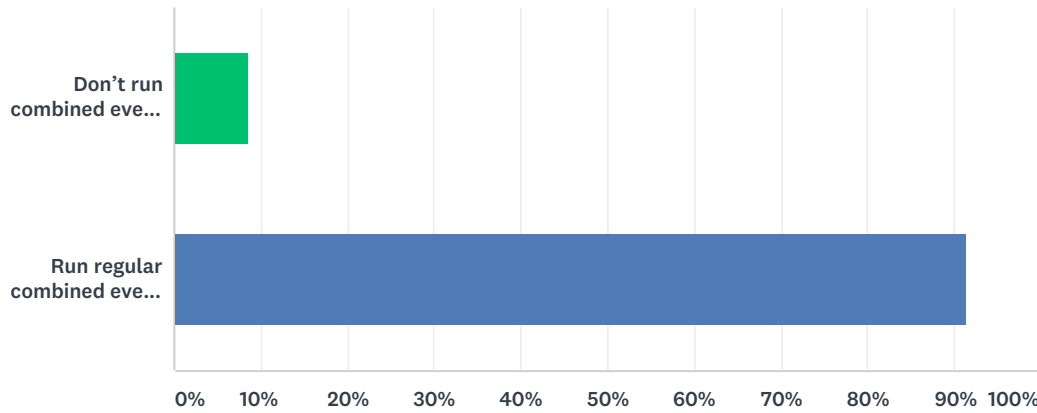

On lap two, the three of us that had been doing everything for 30 kms decided enough, others can do something now, there are 11 other A grade riders who obviously can ride and do some work. They left me on the front for the entire second lap, no matter how slow i rode. I sat on about 25 to 28kmh, and still no one passed me. We were caught by B grade, and almost caught by c grade who started 10 minutes after us. Then there was a 200m sprint at the finish. I was told after thats how vlcc race - just want to stay in draft and sprint at the end. Q6 In general, do you prefer that the 3 SA clubs (select one answer):

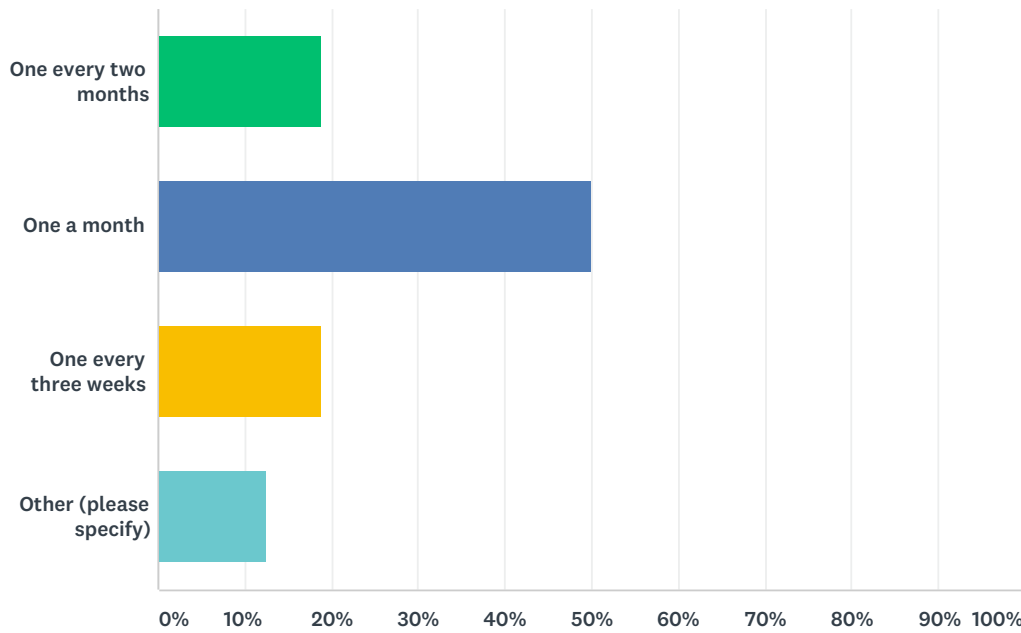

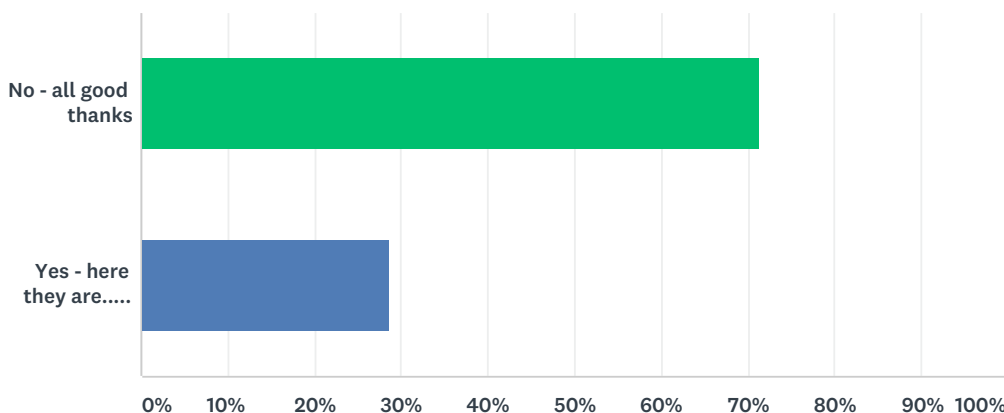
