4. President's report

The President, Sarah Rawlinson, presented this report:

Welcome to our first AGM as an affiliate of Auscycling.

As you all know last year the Club voted to join Auscycling and to open our membership to younger riders so that we were no longer a "masters" (over 30) club. The move was not without some trepidation.

Would our members come with us?

Would there be more demands on us when conducting races?

Would our races be popular?

Overall the decision to move has proved to be a good one. Don will update us on memberships and racing numbers but suffice to say the news is good.

We have certainly had to step up on how we conduct our events. Risk assessment and risk mitigation initially seemed daunting but great work by Dave Degenhardt and Don Clifton with assistance from Lachlan at Auscycling has meant we are now running races with a significantly improved Risk Mitigation. That means more Commissaires, First Aid personnel, and marshals. It means careful course selection and increased signage. All of which is a small price to pay for our No 1 concern, rider safety.

Race participation has been consistently high. From our very first race it was clear that there was a demand for quality road racing. Some clubs had found conducting such races was beyond their resources so all credit to our volunteers who have enabled us race.

Our Tour of Goolwa is now firmly placed on the Auscycling Road Racing Calendar and is a State Level event. It provides a concentrated weekend of Teams' racing in February and is a nice balance for the Super Series in the latter part of the year. We're very proud of the support the event attracts both from riders and Sponsors. That's not to say we wouldn't like some more sponsors!

Thanks to Don we have procedural documents for almost every conceivable Club role from Race Directors to "follow cars". Dave Deg has SAPOL, DIT and Council documentation for every race ready to go all of which is important for the sustainability of the AHCC.

So overall it's been a positive first year with lots of highlights. We've loved seeing the young faces at our events. We've found their enthusiasm and charming manners delightful! That's a good omen for the future of the club.

Our small committee has done a great job pulling it all together. Don, Dave, Simon, Kath, John and Kim you are amazing. If preventing Climate Change was in your hands the world would be in a far better place!

So this is my 11th year as president. For many years I've been searching for someone willing and crazy enough to take over. Don Clifton is going to be standing for President of the AHCC tonight. Not only does he fill that criteria but he also brings managerial and governance skills not often seen in amateur sporting clubs. I can personally vouch for him being a voice of innovation and reason.

I also want to acknowledge all our loyal sponsors and everyone who has volunteered in 2021.

9. Discussion on the year ahead for the club and questions from members

Don Clifton led a discussion on issues facing the club for the year ahead and highlighted:

- Areas of vulnerability, especially in terms of volunteers for tasks including timing, signage and event organisation.
- A likely need to increase the event entry fee for 2022 to \$15 (\$25 if hiring a transponder)

Some of the key points made by members during this discussion were:

- An entry fee of \$15 should not be an issue for the club although a concern was raised that if the entry fee increased to too high a level, it may undermine a willingness of people to volunteer.
- Adding some 'flatter' courses to the event mix could help attract more riders who prefer less climbing.
- It would be useful for the club to seek more volunteers from non-AHCC members who come to race with the club.
